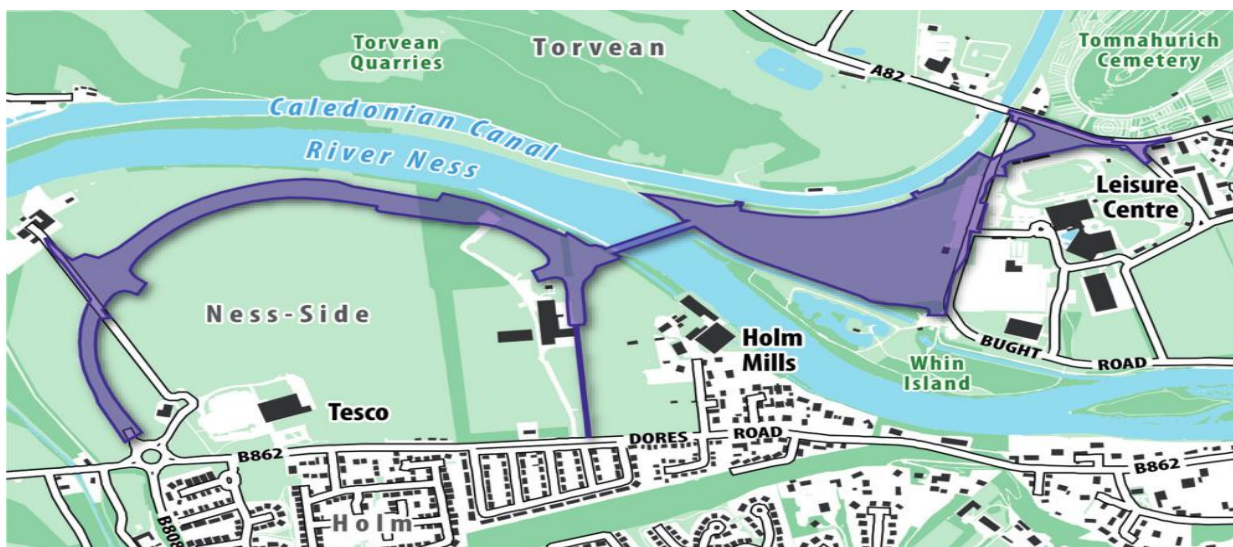


## Site Visit to Inverness West Link Project

Date: Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> October 2016

Time: 2.30pm for 3.00pm till 5.00pm

Venue: Inverness, meet at main site office



The Inverness West Link Project was approved by council members in April 2014 will consist of a new bridge over the River Ness which will connect the Dores roundabout on the B862 to the A82 at Torvean. Preliminary works for the scheme began in September 2015.

The scheme, which has a 4:1 cost benefit ratio, is intended to:

- Significantly reduce traffic congestion in the city centre;
- Deliver economic benefits to the city;
- Reduce carbon emissions and pollution; and
- Improve journey times between the A96 and the A82.

This site visit will be hosted by Wills Bros, who are contractors for Stage 1 of the scheme, and will include a short talk about the project.

This event will be jointly run with the CPD(C) construction professions and is free to attend. Light refreshments will also be available.
