Businesses can now access up to £10,000 worth of funded training through the Flexible Workforce Development Fund (FDWF) to up-skill and re-skill their workforce.

The fund is available to any organisation - private, public and third sector - which currently pays into the UK Government Apprenticeship Levy.

Its aim is to make training and skills development available to staff of any age, helping to address knowledge gaps and improve productivity in Scottish businesses.

Businesses are invited to bid for funding through Colleges.
