

Challenging Beliefs, Affecting Behaviours (CBAB)

Alastair Gill, group HSS adviser with Galliford Try gave an overview of this behavioural safety programme which had been running for 5 years. He was one of 4 regional champions and it had been applied to employees including line management and the supply chain.

Over 1200 CBAB coaches trained, with a strong network in Scotland:

- CBAB coaches on 98% sites
- Coach plans on 100% of sites
- Directors attended CBAB training
- Flexible system adapted for sites

Updates highlighted here are from the 4th September meeting of the forum, sponsored by Morrison Construction who shared their presentation on webpage.
